*Some versions of the SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) vaccine require 1 dose, while others require 2. Quest Diagnostics is able to administer the following COVID-19 vaccine types: Moderna and Janssen (Johnson & Johnson). Availability of each vaccine type will depend on event timing and location. Instruction for use vaccine sheets are available for each vaccine type on the US Food and Drug Administration website.



What would a vaccination program look like?

An on-site vaccination program will be different depending whether a single-dose or 2-dose vaccine is available at the time of the event. Quest Diagnostics will inform the employer which vaccination will be available at the time of contract implementation.



Employer works with Quest to determine on-site event locations, dates, and times.



Guidelines are provided to the employer to ensure there is ample space at the location for the vaccination event(s).



Quest providers arrive on-site on the day(s) of the event(s) to conduct the vaccinations.



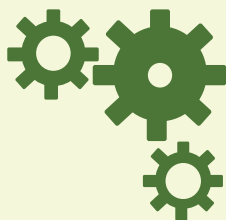
Individuals confirm eligibility and schedule vaccination appointment(s) on the Quest participant site.*



Individuals attend on-site event(s) at their scheduled appointment time(s).



Individuals wait in observation at the work site to ensure there are no adverse reactions to the vaccine.**



Quest manages state and local reporting requirements behind the scenes.



Employer and approved third parties receive reporting to confirm who has been vaccinated.

*Questions are asked when individuals confirm eligibility to determine if it is medically advisable for the individual to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. If the individual is not eligible to receive the vaccine at this time (eg, they are actively taking blood thinners), they will not be able to schedule an appointment and be encouraged to contact their primary care physician to see if/when they should get a COVID-19 vaccine.

**In the event of adverse reactions, Quest Diagnostics providers will call emergency services and deliver epinephrine shots if needed for allergic reactions.
